Information

Fukui Memorial Hospital is a private psychiatric hospital located in Miura-city, Japan.

Our hospital stands in the rural districts in the south of the Miura Peninsula and is surrounded by wide farms spreading on the hills. Farmers nearby cultivate fresh fruits and vegetables. Visitors can see beautiful Mt. Fuji at the top of the hospital.

We treat almost all the psychiatric disorders such as Schizophrenia, Affective Disorders, Panic disorders, Anxiety Disorders, Post-traumatic Stress Disorders, Borderline Personality Disorders, Substance Abuse, Eating Disorders, Pervasive Developmental Disorders, Dementia Related Disorders, etc.

As medical equipment, we have a CT (computerized tomography), a diagnostic X-ray, EEG (electroencephalogram), etc



Our 400 staff members consist of Psychiatrists, Physicians, Nurses, Dentists, Psychologists, Pharmacists, Dietitians, Occupational Therapists, Radiologists, Psychiatric social workers, Care workers and others.

The nursing staffing level is 15:1

History

Fukui Memorial Hospital was established in July 1963 as a private psychiatric hospital (Hasseisou Hospital) by Touichi Fukui, M.D.,P.D. He is one of the pioneers who had fought with stigma and discrimination against the mentally ill throughout his life.

Many psychiatric hospitals were built in Japan between 1955 and 1979. Although most of hospitals had the old style of facility with a locked system and lack of amenities, our hospital had started only with open wards and without symbolic iron-barred windows. After its opening, the name of Hasseisou Hospital has become widely known throughout the country and a lot of patients had come to our hospital. At first, the permitted beds were only 82.

Our hospital changed its title from Hasseisou Hospital to Fukui Memorial Hospital in April 1989, naming after the founder. After a quarter of a century had passed since its establishment, our facility had become too old, we decided to reconstruct the building despite of financial difficulties.

The north facility was opened in September 1992. With rebuilding of our facility, we newly set up a geriatric dementia treatment unit on the first floor. Japan has been facing “a super-aging society” where there is one elderly person every four persons now. That is the reason why we established the floor. It was the first time for a private psychiatric hospital in Kanagawa Prefecture to have a specialized ward for demented elderly patients.



In Japan hospital amenity has been dramatically changing and we thought

that care environment is one of important issues in psychiatric hospitals. So when we reconstructed the North Facility in September 1992, we built a private-room ward on the fourth floor that contained private rooms. It became very popular among patients and families.



We established Nanohana-en as a nursing health institution with 100 beds for the elderly in June 1995. And we built a social rehabilitation facility (Moegi) with 20 beds near our hospital that promotes the mentally ill to return to society in January 1999. At the same time we established a new rehabilitation building that has a multi-purpose room for occupational therapy and a wide day care room.

In addition to that, we built another new facility on July, 2005. In the South Facility we have a super acute unit, a special ward for the adolescent, and a ward for patients with complications.

Now we have 442 permitted beds for inpatients. Occupational therapy for psychiatric inpatients and daycare for outpatients are permitted. And we started home care services and visiting medical treatment since 2006.

To develop community care for outpatients we started Tsukuihama Clinic in April 2017.
